### Appointment

Dr. F. Mason Sones, Jr. has been made a member of the permanent staff in the Department of Cardiorespiratory Disease. Dr. Sones graduated from Western Maryland College in 1940 and from the University of Maryland School of Medicine in 1943. He interned at the University Hospital in Baltimore. During 1944 to 1946 he served in the Medical Corps of the U. S. Army Air Force, after which he spent 3 years as resident at Henry Ford Hospital. His residency included 2 years in Internal Medicine and 1 year in Cardiology. In 1949 Dr. Sones was appointed to the Staff in Pediatric Cardiology at Henry Ford Hospital, which position he occupied until his appointment at the Cleveland Clinic in October, 1950.
